## SCOPE

---

This policy provides guidance on the uniform required to be worn by students in the Primary and Secondary School.

## PURPOSE

---

Quinns Baptist College has established a Uniform Policy which states that all students who attend the College will be required to wear correct College uniform. This contributes to:

- The fostering and enhancement of the public image of the College
- Improving morale, team spirit and pride in the College
- Ensuring that students are safely dressed for College activities
- Encouraging equity among students, reducing rivalry
- Identifying non-College children on-campus.

All children are required to wear the College uniform in a manner which is a credit to the student and the College.

All items are available for purchase from the Uniform Shop located on site with exception to shoes and sports briefs.

## GENERAL STANDARDS OF DRESS

---

Students should wear their uniform correctly at all times. The following guidelines should be followed:

- Uniform items should be properly fitting.
- Formal shirts should be tucked in (boys).
- Skirts must be no shorter than approximately 3cm above the knee.
- Sports shorts should be no shorter than approximately 10cm above the knee.
- Socks should be approximately 3 - 5cm above the ankle.
- Coloured nail polish is not permitted.
- Make-up is not permitted (Primary)
- Make-up must be natural looking (Secondary) and not excessive.
- Artificial nails are not permitted (Primary)
- Artificial nails should be short and natural looking (Secondary)
- Boys should be clean shaven. Facial hair (beards or moustaches) are not permitted.
- Non-uniform apparel is not permitted to be worn under any circumstance.

## Jewellery

Watches are permitted (must be removed for an exam).

Only one pair of plain earrings are permitted in the lower ear lobes.

Additional piercings are not permitted under any circumstances.

No other jewellery is permitted.

## Tattoos

Tattoos of any kind are not permitted to be visible when in uniform (including Henna tattoos). Tattoos must be covered up at all times.

## Hair

- Conventional hair styles only are permitted. Students will be required to modify any hairstyle deemed unconventional.
- Hair longer than the collar must be completely tied up at all times.
- Hair is to be kept from falling in front of the eyes.
- Natural hair colours only are permitted (includes tints).

## Accessories

- Hair accessories should be plain and not decorative.
- Gloves must be plain black and not fingerless gloves.
- Students are permitted to wear the College scarf only.
- Secondary students are only permitted to wear the College beanie outdoors.
- Sunglasses are permitted to be worn outdoors only.
- College hats must be worn when in the sun for all outdoor class activities and during breaks.

## Non-uniform clothing

Clothing that is not an approved Uniform item is not permitted to be worn with the College Uniform e.g. Sports Jumpers, hoodies, jackets, etc.

## House Days

Sports uniform must be worn on House Days with the College House shirt instead of the College Sport shirt (see the calendar for specified days).

## Co-Curricular Inter-school Sports

Students involved in the co-curricular sports must wear the designated uniform for that sport. Tops/dresses will be provided by the College. For team sports. The College shorts must be worn for all sports requiring shorts.

## Second Hand Clothing

Only the current uniform can be purchased second hand. Uniform items which have been phased out should not be sold or purchased second hand. Students are not permitted to wear phased out uniform items.

## PRIMARY UNIFORM ITEMS

---

*Kindergarten and Pre Primary Students:* Red shirt and teal shorts or skort and red tracksuit.

*Year 1 and 2 Students:* Wear sports uniform all year and are not required to purchase the formal uniform .

## Sports Uniform

Sports uniform is only to be worn on nominated sports or physical education days or when notified by the school.

## Season Changeovers

Summer uniform is worn in Terms 1 and 4 and the winter uniform is worn in Terms 2 and 3. At the uniform changeover (i.e. at the start of winter and summer) a 2 week grace period will be allowed.

## Bags

The **red** College back pack for Primary School is compulsory. Bags must be kept in good condition and not covered in graffiti. Unsatisfactory bags will need to be replaced.

## Scarves

Only red scarves purchased from the uniform shop are permitted.

## SECONDARY UNIFORM ITEMS

---

The uniform can be worn all year round with acceptable variations for weather changes. The Secondary College has a Formal Uniform and Sports Uniform.

### Formal Uniform

The Formal Uniform is to be worn on days where no physically-based lessons are timetabled for the student. The formal uniform must be worn neat and tidy at all times including on the way to and from school or when in public. Students should be well presented at all times, i.e: clean shaven, hair neat and tidy.

## Sports Uniform

Students are to wear the Sports Uniform for the full day when they have the following classes timetabled:

- Physical Education
- Fitness
- Phys Ed Studies (double lesson only)
- Dance
- Outdoor Education
- Outdoor Recreation VET (double lesson only)
- Sport and Recreation VET
- Rugby Union

At times, classroom teachers may prefer students to wear their Sports Uniform for practical activities. This should be communicated to parents by the classroom teacher prior to the designated lesson through SMS.

## School Bags

The College bag is **compulsory**. Bags must be kept in good condition and not covered in graffiti. Unsatisfactory bags will need to be replaced. Students will not be permitted to use other non-College bags, unless it is a requirement that extra items be brought to school for the day.

## Achievement Badges

Senior students awarded with achievement badges should hand stitch them on to the left breast of their College jackets.

## Leavers Jackets

Year 12 students may wear their Leavers Jacket instead of the College Jacket.
